



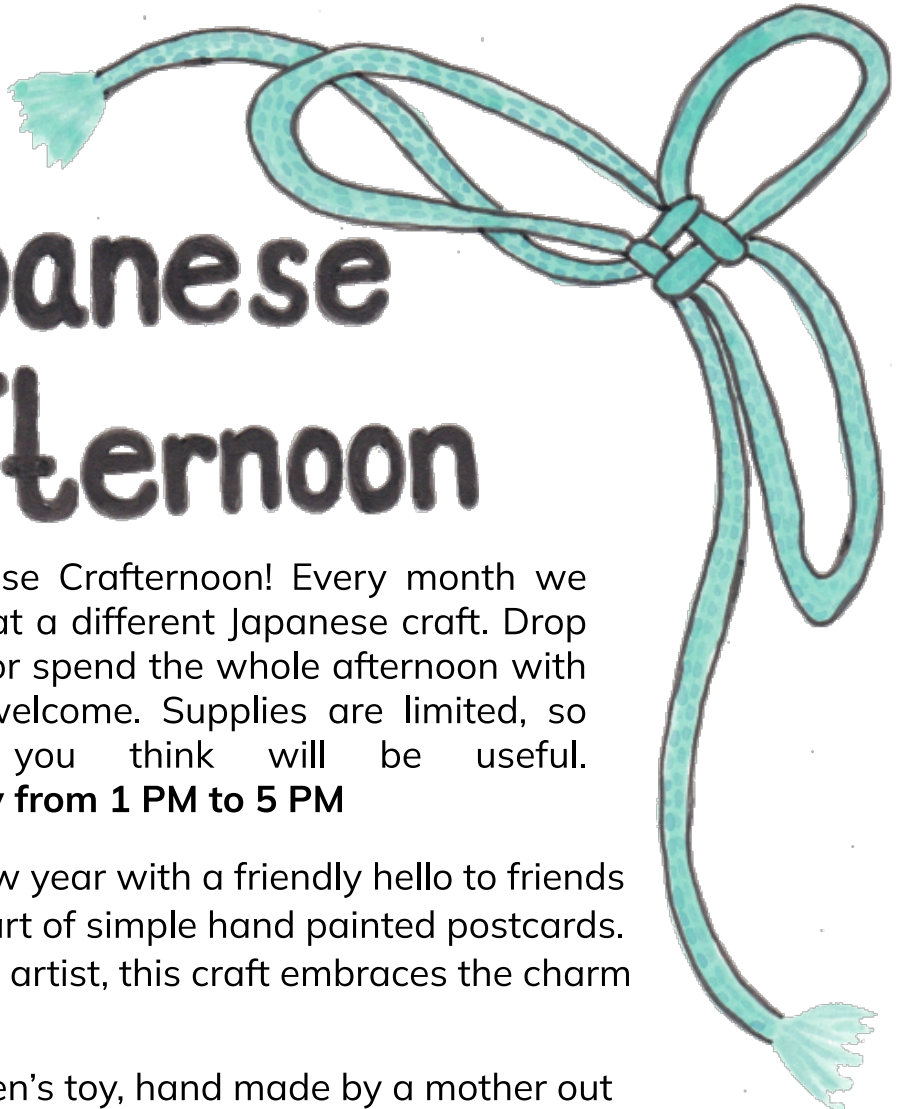
Japanese Crafternoon

3/20 Kumihimo: Kumihimo is the art of braiding thread to make cords. This type of decorative cord can often be seen worn with a kimono. We will be making a bracelet that used the same techniques.
